



Instructions for configuring the proxy service in the Firefox browser

To configure the proxy service in the Firefox browser is necessary to take the following steps:

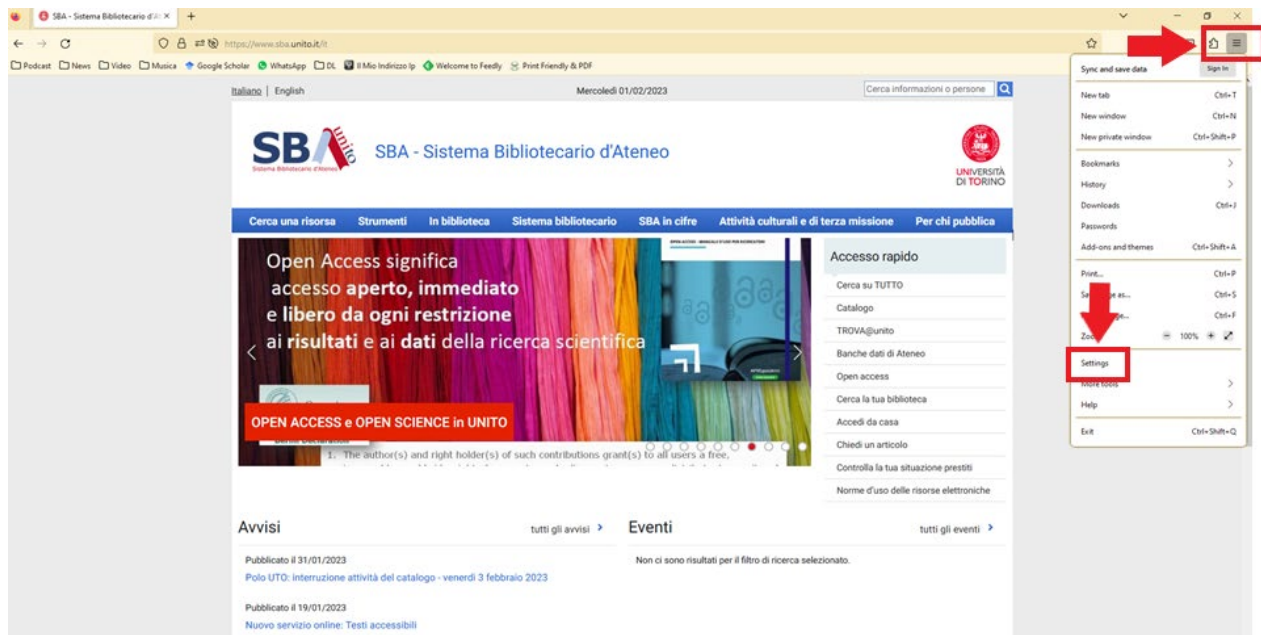


Figure 1 – Settings

1. click on the Menu icon in the top right-hand corner and select the "Settings" item (see figure 1)

2. once the "General" panel is open, scroll down the page and click on the "Settings" button in the "Network Settings" section (see figure 2)

3. Now tick "Manual proxy configuration", then enter the text **proxy.unito.it** in the "HTTP proxy" box and the value **3128** in the "Port" box, as shown in figure 3. Also tick "Use this proxy also for HTTPS". Once the configuration is complete, click on the "OK" button.
